# MARCH MADNESS OCPS ROBOTICS CODING TOURNAMENT





### **GREAT OC BOARD-**WALK FIRE OF 1927



The Ocean City, NJ boardwalk burnt down in 1927 and you would never know it today. It is hard to believe! My grandma was alive during this disaster but she was not on the boardwalk at the time of the fire.

30 buildings were destroyed by the fire. The boardwalk fire caused \$4,000,000 in damage. One person died in the fire and some firefighters were also injured. Buildings, hotels, theatres, shops, and garages had some serious damage. The fire started under an arcade. The wind blew the fire until it stretched 8 blocks and destroyed everything. When the boardwalk was rebuilt it was built 300 feet closer to the beach. We wanted to talk to a firefighter to see if they had ever heard of the fire so we contacted Mr. Stamm.

We asked him if he had heard of the boardwalk fire? He said, "I have heard of it, I heard stories of how big the fire was and how it reshaped the boardwalk as we know it today. When the boardwalk was rebuilt, they moved it the length of a football field closer to the ocean and they used cement pilings to rebuild the foundation instead of wood. Any building that needed to be moved from the old location was transported using rails and horses."

We asked, "have you ever been on a boardwalk fire call?" He said, "I have not been on a boardwalk fire, but there was a fire at the 7th Street Surf Shop on the boardwalk since I joined the fire department. I was not on duty for that fire and fortunately the fire was put out before it spread too much."

We asked, "How long does it take to put out a boardwalk fire?" He said, "The time it takes to put out a fire depends on the size of the fire. Almost every fire starts small, but grows quickly. This is why it is important to get out of the house and call 911 as soon as you can! Some fires can be put out in seconds with a fire extinguisher. while other fires can burn for days with constant streams of water flowing onto them!"

We were really excited to talk to Mr. Stamm about fires and remember what he said, "If you have a fire, get out of the house and call 911 as soon as you can!"
