Topic	Reading, speaking, listening about basic everyday conversation topics		
Purpose	The purpose of this assignment is to help students to review basic things they have learned about Spanish, as well as allowing them to learn about other topics they're interested in.		
Text/Novel(s) & Brief Description			
		Students will use the duolingo app for 5 minutes at a time to review basic Spanish topics they are familiar with, and to explore other topics that they are interested in. They will use conjugemos.com to review basic Spanish vocabulary & grammar that they have learned.	
Approximate Time on Task			
		Duolingo App: 5 minutes a day, 4-5 times/week Studyspanish.com: about 1-2 hours	
Suggested Timeline			
		Beginning of July-beginning of September, about 8 weeks	
How It Will Be Assessed			
		100 points total. 10 points--Sign up for Remind 30 points--Studyspanish.com 60 points--Duolingo App 60 points—4-5 sessions/week 50 points—3 sessions/week 40 points—2 session/week 30 points or less—fewer than 1 session/week / sporadic Students can make up missed sessions by doing more than 4 per week, or by completing additional sessions by Oct 1.

The summer assignments will be 10% of your first marking period grade. There are 3 things to do:

1. **First, sign up for the Remind App. (10 pts)** If you have any questions, please use Remind to contact me (señora Palomeque), do not use email, as I don't check email regularly during the summer. Download the App if you don't already have it, then use the code @esp1h2021 to sign up. **Please use your name to sign up, so I know who you are when you contact me, and so I know who to give the points to.**

Once you do this, then you're done with #1. (That was easy!)

2. **Use Duolingo Classroom. (60 pts)**

Overview: This assignment is designed to be easy to do, to take up just a few minutes at a time, and to be **fun!** Duolingo will help you review basic things you may already know, and learn some more things about topics you're interested in. It can also help improve your pronunciation skills if you repeat the words/phrases after they are said. **Please do this!**

Important: **Begin as soon as possible!** You need to show you have been using Duolingo on a regular basis, so Don't wait for the end of the summer. After you sign up to the classroom, I will be able to see your progress.

How to use Duolingo:

Practice using this app for 5 minutes (or more), 4-5 times each week. To get full credit, you will need to show you have been using Duolingo 4 times/week for 8 weeks.

(Students who switch into Sp I HN late / at the end of the summer, **don't worry!** Contact me and I will work with you so you can make-up for missed practice. Just start as soon as you can.)

How to get started. Your class—"2021-22 Español I H"

You MUST your real first and last name for your profile name

If you are on a smartphone or tablet:

1. Download the Duolingo app and open it up.
2. Press *Get Started*, then select Spanish.
3. Set your Daily Goal for 5 minutes and continue
4. Create a Profile:
 - On Android, press the menu icon at the top right corner and press *Create a Profile*
 - On IOS, press *Profile* in the top left corner and press *Create a Profile*
5. Type in your Name, Email and Password, then press *Create*

If you don't use your name, I won't know it your work, and you will not receive credit

6. Go to your Profile and press *Progress Sharing*
7. Type in your **Classroom Code: MPPZXF**
8. Press *Join Class*.

Options for you:

- You can take a placement test to see what level you would place into, or...
- You can just start at the beginner level, and work your way up.
- You can also choose specific topics you're interested in, or read/listen to stories.

3. Studyspanish.com (30 pts)

Unlike Duolingo, this would be better to do later in the summer, rather than in the beginning. (Preferably not before August)

- Sign up for the **free account**, **MUST use your real name**, so it will be listed as you when you print your report card at the end. You will need to use an email account to verify your sign up. **Your Ocean City student email is NOT a real email, so you can't use it to sign up. Here are instructions to sign up:**

HOW TO REGISTER AS A STUDENT

- Go to **www.studyspanish.com**.
 - Click on the circle to the left of the screen, SIGN UP.
 - Click on "Membership Levels."
 - Select "Free User Membership".
 - Fill out the form and check the verification box at the very bottom.
 - Click "Submit and Confirm".
 - Check your email and confirm the account by following the link provided in the message sent out by the system.
 - You may now log on as a student.
- **Sign in every time you work on this site, and your work will be saved. (If you don't sign in, it won't be saved.)**

After signing in click on the **Grammar** Tab, then select **Unit one**, which has basic beginner Spanish topics that students are generally familiar with already.

For each of the 14 topics in Unit 1, you will complete the "Basic Quiz," as follows:

Select each topic by clicking on the number and name of the activity. For example, in Unit 1, the first topic is, "1. Gender of Nouns I" On the right it will say "Notes" Please REVIEW the NOTES for each topic BEFORE selecting the basic quiz, this will give you hints and important information.

- After reviewing the "Notes" section, select the **"Basic Quiz"** for each topic, complete the activity and click "submit my answers". If you got any incorrect, go back and fix them, then submit your answers again. When you have 100%, you are done with that activity.

After you have completed ALL basic quizzes for Unit 1, print out your report card, and turn it in in class. Here's how to print your report card:

- click on the drop-down arrow next to log-in/out on the top right, and select **"My Account"**
- **Then, under "My Account" on the left select, "Report Card" and on the right "Grammar"**
- Select all of the reports from Unit 1. It will say, "incomplete," because you completed only the Basic Quiz (Don't worry, it's supposed to say this.)
- After checking off all the reports you completed, **click on "View Reports" at the top,** and that will take you to your Report card. The Report Card will show all the reports you did and when. Print the report card, making sure it is clear and legible.

The report card you hand in should show the lesson #, the date you completed it.

(MUST BE summer 2021), and a score of 100%.
