What is The Purpose of a SEPAG?

- To provide direct input on the policies, programs, and practices that impact services and supports for students with disabilities and their families to the district.
- To increase the involvement of families of children with special needs in making recommendations on special education policy.

Who Should Attend SEPAG Meetings?

- Anyone with a student or students eligible for or receiving services under an IEP or 504 plan.
- Interested members of the school community.

The Ocean City School District is looking for interested parents and community members to join and lead this important parent group. Please note that this is **NOT** a forum for a discussion about individual students or your child's IEP. The participation in SEPAG benefits the broader community as it considers the needs of a child as part of the big picture for all students and families in the district.
