MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING MARCH 23, 2022

CALL TO ORDER

The Regular Meeting of the Ocean City Board of Education was called to order by President Kane on Wednesday, March 23, 2022, at 6:30 p.m. in the Ocean City High School Library, 501 Atlantic Avenue, Ocean City, NJ.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: that the Ocean City Board of Education approves the budget to be submitted to the County Superintendent of Schools for review and approval,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: pursuant to N.J.A.C. 6A:23A-7.3, budgeted travel expenses do not exceed \$45,000,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: pursuant to N.J.A.C. 6A:23A-5.2(a), maximum dollar amounts for public relations and professional services have been established and are detailed in the appropriations section of the 2022-23 budget,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: that \$400,000 be withdrawn from the Maintenance Reserve Account to be utilized for required maintenance at District schools,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: that \$150,000 be withdrawn from the Emergency Reserve Account to be utilized for District security upgrades,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: that \$1,900,000 be withdrawn from the Tuition Reserve Account,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: that \$225,000 be withdrawn from the Capital Reserve Account,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: that the 2022-2023 budget includes the use of banked cap in the amount of \$88,367. These funds are required for the 2022-2023 budget to offset increases in health care and tuition costs and cannot be deferred or incrementally completed over a longer period of time.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: that the public hearing for the 2022-23 school year budget will be held on Wednesday, April 27, 2022, in the High School Library/Media Center at 7:00 p.m., and will be followed by a regular meeting,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: that the School Business Administrator/Board Secretary is authorized to advertise said tentative budget in accordance with the format required by the State Department of Education and according to law.

J. Postage Meter Lease

The Board approves the five-year lease of postage machines from Pitney Bowes effective April 1, 2022, through March 31, 2027, at a monthly cost of \$1,104.05. This lease replaces the previously

leased equipment from Pitney Bowes that expired on March 31, 2022, and is being awarded through Sourcewell / NJPA Contract #041917-PIT.
